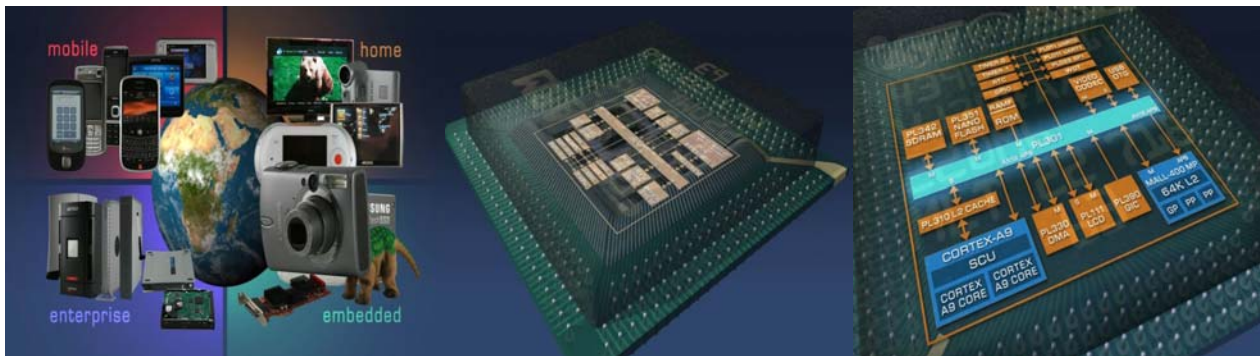
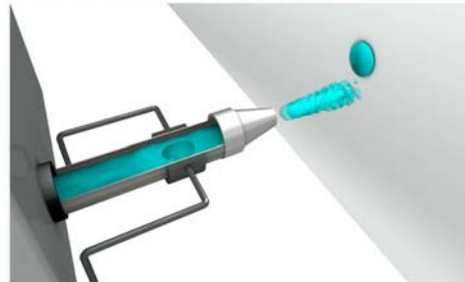


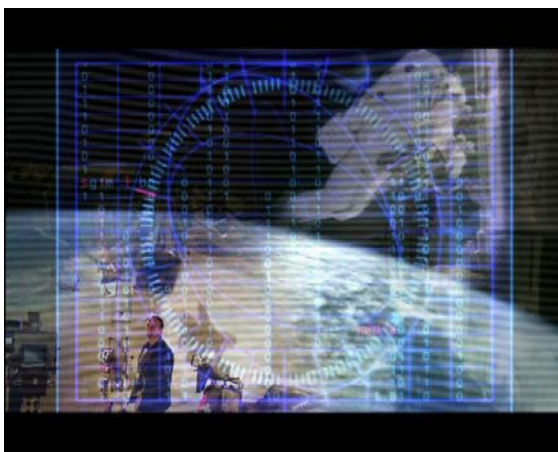
Graphics
